OVERVIEW

The ALDI SOUTH Group has set the goal for each individual country to reduce greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions per m² of sales area by 30% by 2020. All percentage values listed in this document constitute comparisons against the base year 2012.

GHG EMISSIONS

In 2018, all ALDI SOUTH country groups achieved the reduction goal in 2018 two years ahead of time.
